

Global airline revenue




• Total airline revenue is expected to recover to around 96% of the pre-Covid level in 2023




International RPKs, YoY% change versus 2019 – Top 10 route areas in 2019



- Recovery among the route areas, experiencing remarkable growth with rising sign
- Tremendous growth in Asia Pacific is rapidly closing the gap with the rest of the world as airlines resume normal operations.

International RPKs, YTD June 2023 (%) Top 10 route areas, ranked by 2019 traffic level



- Europe and North America took the lead in recovery among the route areas, experiencing a 4.9% growth over H1 2019 and a remarkable 36.3% increase in RPKs compared to H1 2022.
- Passenger traffic within Asia Pacific achieved significant growth over the first half of 2023, with a 379.9% increase over the period.


International Tourist Arrivals: 1 Jan – 10 Sep 2023^P









THAI Resumes Bangkok-Sapporo





THAI Resumes Bangkok-Sapporo Roundtrip Flight from 2 August - 28 October 2023

Thai Airways International Public Company Limited (THAI) will resume the Bangkok-Sapporo roundtrip flight operations, utilizing Boeing 787-9, to five times a week during the summer flight schedule from 2 August - 28 October 2023 in response to the growing travel demand in Japanese destinations. Flight details below:

- 1.) TG670 Bangkok-Sapporo on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday departing from Bangkok at 23.45 hours and arriving in Sapporo at 08.30 hours of the next day (local time)
- 2.) TG671 Sapporo-Bangkok on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday departing from Sapporo at 10.00 hours (local time) and arriving in Bangkok at 15.00 hours


