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

Thai Airways

1Q 2024 Total revenue is recovered to **92.3%*** of the pre-COVID level

THAI

- Total airline revenue in 2023 is estimated to be **107%** of pre-pandemic levels, driven by strong passenger revenue growth.
- Asia-Pacific, the most passenger demand growth , accounting for more than half of the total global increase.


- Passenger revenue to reach USD 642 billion in 2023, up 47% from 2022.
- Cargo revenue to decline by 35% in 2023 due to lower demand and falling freight rates.

Regional Contribution to industry annual total RPK growth





 - Despite not fully recovering pre-pandemic traffic levels by 2023, both regions show strong momentum towards recovery, particularly in international travel.










Top 5 Number of Tourist Arrivals




1Q 2024: Operating profit movement

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
